The morning session will focus on upskilling intermediaries' core practices and during the afternoon session we will consider & debate new developments across the justice system.

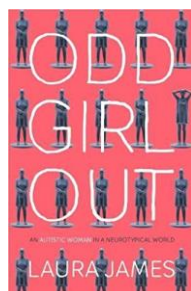
