- We have robust and flexible plans to ensure we can continue to deliver key services across the justice system.
- A network of priority courts will remain open during the coronavirus pandemic to make sure the justice system continues to operate effectively.
- Prisons are well prepared to take immediate action wherever cases or suspected cases are identified, including the isolation of individuals where necessary. We are issuing secure phone handsets to help offenders keep in contact with their families

Updated guidance is now available for friends and families of prisoners. It provides information on prison visits, the changes to regimes and Parole Board hearings and trials. Prisons are well prepared to take immediate action wherever cases or suspected cases are identified, including the isolation of individuals where necessary. HMPPS has been working closely with Public Health England and NHS services, as well as criminal justice partners, to put robust contingency plans in place. The plans prioritise the safety of staff, prisoners, visitors and offenders under supervision in the community, whilst seeking to minimise disruption to normal services and ensure public protection. NEW: HMCTS has updated guidance on gov.uk to advise court and tribunal users on use of telephone and video hearings to ensure the essential work of our courts and tribunals continues. A network of priority courts will remain open during the coronavirus pandemic to make sure the justice system continues to operate effectively. The work of courts and tribunals will be consolidated into fewer buildings, maintaining the safety of all in the courts and in line with public health advice. There will be 157 priority court and tribunal buildings open for essential face-to-face hearings.
