


Intermediaries: A Voice for the Voiceless

Guidance for requesting an Intermediary - pathway

For witnesses

The interviewing officer

- 1. Asks permission for a Registered Intermediary e.g. from their DI or DS.
- 2. Downloads an RFS form on the police intranet.
- 3. Can ring the Witness Team as above.
- 4. Returns the form to the NCA with a cost code/purchase order.

 \checkmark

An Intermediary

- 1. Is matched to the case.
- 2. Is sent a request for a service RFS contract by the NCA
- 3. Contacts the IO.
